Volunteers attended and monitored **50+ public meetings** to advocate for greener government policy





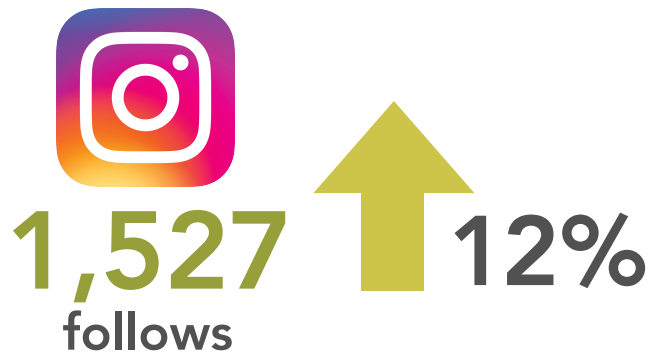
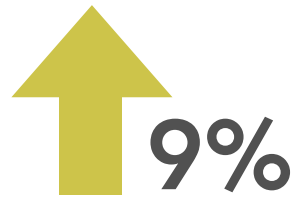
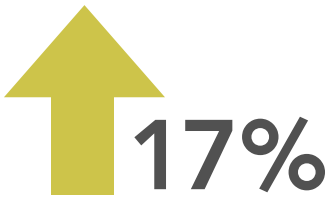

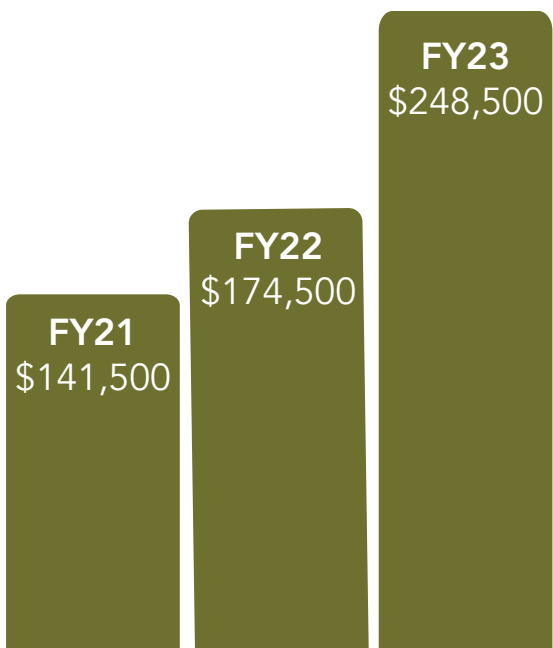

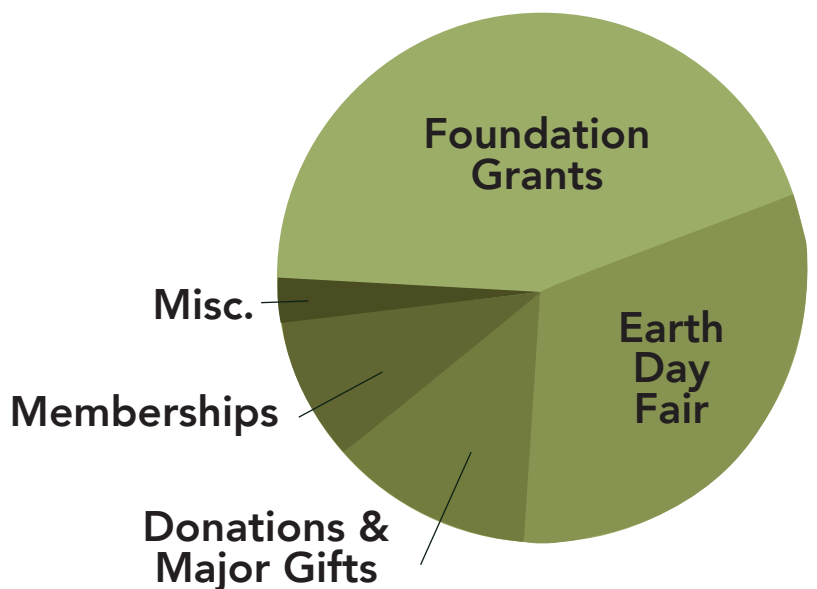
More people than ever are engaged with PEA!
